DATA & PRIVACY POLICY

1. ABOUT YOUR DATA AND INFORMATION PRIVACY

- 1.1 ZECO Australian Energy Solutions Pty Ltd, ABN 91 169 556 745 trading as Marshall, (Marshall) respects your right to privacy and is committed to safeguarding the privacy of our customers and website visitors. This policy sets out how we collect and treat your personal information.
- 1.2 "Personal information" or "information" is information we hold which is identifiable as being about you. This includes information such as your name, email address, identification number, or any other type of information that can reasonably identify an individual, either directly or indirectly. This may also include your business information.

4. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION (PERSONAL OR OTHERWISE)
